

New NRH City Hall Opening Soon

Your new North Richland Hills City Hall is expected to be open for business by the end of March 2016. The facility, located at 4301 City Point Drive, brings together city services into one convenient location including city hall, public safety and municipal court services.

The relocation of city services to the new facility is being phased in throughout March beginning with Information Technology, Municipal Court, Parks Administration and Citicable NRH; followed by Dispatch, Fire Administration and the Police Department; and finally Neighborhood Services and the city offices located in our old City Hall at 7301 NE Loop 820. It is anticipated that the old City Hall will be closed Friday, March 25 and Monday March 28 to move and we will reopen at the new facility on Tuesday, March 29. Emergency services will continue to operate without interruptions. Throughout the transition, the city's online bill payment and telephone ser-

vices will remain available.

The new City Hall is located off Boulevard 26, on a portion of the old North Hills Mall site. It includes about 89,000 square feet for Public Safety operations, about 78,500 square feet for City Hall services and about 14,500 square feet for Municipal Court. North Richland Hills voters approved construction of the new facility in May 2012.

The property surrounding your new City Hall is privately owned and represented by ARA Newmark, a national commercial real estate brokerage with local offices in Dallas. The city is working closely with ARA Newmark on marketing the property and meeting with prospective parties interested in purchasing and developing the property.

The community is invited to a grand opening celebration at the new City Hall on May 13. The event will include an open house with tours from 3 p.m. to 9 p.m., a ribbon cutting at 6 p.m. and concert at 7 p.m. Watch for more information in your spring city newsletter and on the city's website at www.nrhtx.com.

Dispose of Bulky Items

North Richland Hills residents can get rid of unwanted bulky items during the annual Spring Community Cleanup on Saturday, April 16, 2016. Items can be dropped off from 9:00 a.m. to noon at the Tarrant County College Northeast Campus, 828 Harwood Road (Parking lot E.1 by tennis courts). Proof of residency (driver's license or water bill) must be presented.

Residents may get rid of brush, furniture, stoves, washers, dryers, dishwashers, containerized bricks, rocks or concrete and other bulky items. Tires (without rims) and fire extinguishers will also be accepted for proper disposal. Hazardous waste will not be accepted.

Paper shredding will also be provided at this event. Residents can bring up to five average-size file boxes of paper to be securely shredded on-site and then recycled.
