(Water Irrigation System Evaluation) Guys is a conservation program offered by the Tarrant Regional Water District to residential water customers in North Richland Hills and other communities. The program provides area water customers with a free check of their irrigation system and tips on how to operate it more efficiently.

This program has the ability to conserve millions of gallons of water each year, which helps the water district meet its water conservation goals. Know Your Watering Schedule

The city of North Richland Hills reminds all water customers that you may use sprinklers or irrigation systems no more than twice per week based on the following schedule:

Monday

No sprinkling, irrigation allowed

Tuesday & Friday

Non-residential sites (businesses, apartments, park, common areas)

Wednesday & Saturday

Residential addresses ending in 0, 2, 4, 6, 8

Thursday & Sunday

Residential addresses ending in 1, 3, 5, 7, 9

No watering between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day.

Protect Yourself from Mosquito-Borne Viruses

Aside from being itchy and annoying, the bite of an infected mosquito can spread West Nile Virus, as well as diseases such as Chikungunya and Zika virus which may be imported to North Texas by infected travelers. Personal protection from mosquito bites is the best way to prevent the spread of these diseases.

Use Insect Repellent

- Use repellents when you are outside, day and night. Choose EPA-registered insect repellents, which are proven safe and effective. The effectiveness of non-EPA registered insect repellents, including some natural repellents, is not known.
- Always follow the product label instructions and reapply insect repellent every few hours, depending on which product and strength you choose.
- Apply sunscreen first and insect repellent second (combination products are not recommended).

- Always follow instructions when applying insect repellent to children.
- Do not use insect repellent on babies younger than 2 months of age. Dress your child in clothing that covers arms and legs, or cover crib, stroller, and baby carrier with mosquito netting.

Mosquito-Proof Your Home

- Use screens on windows and doors. Repair holes in screens to keep mosquitoes outside.
 - Keep mosquitoes from laying eggs in and near standing water. Once a week, empty and scrub, turn over, cover, or throw out items that hold water, such as tires, buckets, planters, toys, pools, birdbaths, flowerpots, or trash containers.
