WHY RECYCLE?

Good for the environment



Recycling helps save natural resources and energy. Plus recycling helps prevent litter. According to the U. S. EPA, nearly 90 percent of the plastic water bottles we use in the U. S. get tossed in the trash or become litter: Recycling programs prevent such waste.

Good public relations

Residents are accustomed to recycling at home, work and on campus. More and more often those attending special events want to be able to recycle. Now, thanks to funding from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) offering recycling is easier at these types of events in the Dallas/Fort Worth area.

Save money and resources

The EPA estimates that 75 percent of what Americans throw in the trash could actually be recycled.

According to the U. S. EPA, between 1990 and 2000, Americans threw out more than 7 million tons of aluminum cans—enough aluminum to reproduce the world's entire commercial air fleet 25 times.

- Lid with labeled holes
